#### **Christi Whiteside**

- North Carolina State Board of Education Policy LICN-004 changes
  - o The requirements for a mentor teacher have been changed.
  - It is necessary for schools to reflect this change in their Board approved Beginning Teacher Support Program Plans.
  - o Christi Whiteside has submitted these changes as well as made a few additions to ECS's previously approved plan.
  - These changes and the current plan have all been approved by DPI, but need to be approved by the ECS Board.
  - Draft of ECS Beginning Teacher Support Program Plan attached. Summary of significant changes:
    - Required statement about mentors for beginning teachers;
    - Support for Beginning Teachers includes:
      - Observes a peer a minimum of 4 times per year using the BT and Mentor Observation form
      - Meets with the appropriate Curriculum Coordinator on a weekly basis
      - Is provided an opportunity to discuss their progress on personal and school focuses in a quarterly check-in with a Curriculum Coordinator or the Director.

## • Motion to Approve Beginning Teacher Support Program Plan by Bill Kroll

- o Passed unanimously
- The 10 Year Renewal Process is coming to an end.
  - o Charter School Advisory Board meetings are happening today and tomorrow.
  - We received a unanimous vote for a 10 year charter renewal.
  - o The State Board of Education must now vote to approve this recommendation.
