 - o Just under \$1,000.00 raised. Need \$1,600.00 for 20 x 20 shelter. This is reduced from the normal price of \$2,500.00.

 - Passed unanimously
- Secretary Board position
 - o Bill Kroll nominated Tracy DeMarco
 - o There were no other nominations or volunteers
 - Bill Kroll moved to appoint Tracy DeMarco as Secretary beginning July 1, 2018
 - Kristy McClure seconded
 - Passes unanimously
- Upcoming Board meeting dates

• Finance Committee:

Kristy McClure

- o Review April 2018 Financials
 - Looking at a surplus of about \$200,000.00

- Bonuses for teachers and staff
 - Took Annual Fund out so this was not an incentive
 - Christi Whiteside proposed \$1,000.00 as the base which is prorated based upon full time
 - Kristy McClure moved to approve the \$1,000.00 bonus for teachers and staff
 - Kim Keith seconded
 - Passed unanimously
- Salary Scale for 2018-19
 - Discussion that amended language for salary scale that was approved at last meeting is used. This language needs to go to Molly Blanchard.
 - Kristy McClure led discussion that the standard for a healthy financial statement for schools needs to target 65% of its budget to salaries. Currently ECS exceeds 65%.
 - These numbers were considered.
 - State increased percentage for retirement by 1%. This took away \$29,000.00 from being paid directly to teachers.
 - Once these numbers were taken into account, the Finance Committee recommended that the Salary Scale be increased 1.1% across the board.
 - These numbers are reflected in the Proposed Budget.
 - Kristy McClure moved to approve Salary Scale for 2018-19 with 1.1% increase.
 - Kim Keith seconded
 - Passed unanimously
- Budget for 2018-19
 - The Board would like to recognize the work that Molly Blanchard and Kristy McClure put into preparing the Budget.
 - Following amendments were made to Budget:
 - Add Line item for Guidance Counselor at \$20,000
 - Increased salary line item in budget to reflect Lauren Manfreda increasing work time from 4 days to 5 days
 - Increased budget item for Spring Annual Fund revenue from \$20,000 to \$36,000
 - Added \$5,000 to General Insurance
 - Added \$5,000 to Instructional Supplies
 - Capital Purchases line item being adjusted from \$0 to \$20,000
 - Building Repairs line item being adjusted from \$32,064.06 to \$52,064.06
 - Budgeted surplus of \$6,000
 - Kristy McClure moved to pass 2018-19 Budget as Amended above
 - Nick Cerullo seconded
 - Passed unanimously

 - 177 responses
 - largely positive
 - Number 1 way to volunteer is lunch duty
 - Fundraising issues: 111 said they had given and 39 said they would still be giving before end of year
 - High priority: Addition of gym, going to grade 12, school counselor
 - Direct pledge was choice for paying for these items
 - o In planning for next year and fund raising, goals have gone from \$100,000 to \$120,000. Next year suggestion would be \$150,000.
 - About ½ should come from direct donations.
 - Participation has dropped, but average donation has increased.
 - o Would like to target building this up
