- The Art Show and Book Fair will run from February 25th to March 1st. Art can be purchased on Wednesday (27th) and Thursday (28th) evenings 6pm–8pm. PAWS has arranged for food trucks to be available at the event both nights (Mexican food on the 27th and mac and cheese on the 28th). • Finance Committee (~10 min)

- Bond Audit
 - Our attorneys have completed the audit response and will be sending the requested information to the IRS later this week.
- Except for expenses associated with the audit, which was unanticipated, the School is on budget for the year.
- o Amendment to Credit Agreement and engagement of counsel
 - The Finance Committee has been working with BBVA to execute an amendment to the debt calculation ratio. However, Endeavor needs to engage counsel to review the amendment before executing it. McGuireWoods represented the School with respect to execution of the initial credit agreement and subsequent amendment. Accordingly, the Finance Committee would like to re-engage McGuireWoods to review the latest amendment.
 - Israa Kanfoud moved to engage McGuireWoods to represent the School with respect to review and execution of the credit agreement amendment.
 - Bill Kroll seconded.
 - Tracy DeMarco abstained.
 - Motion passed unanimously.
- o Molly is actively working to prepare the budget for next year, and the Finance Committee will circulate the document for the Board's review as soon as possible.

- o By-laws
 - The Governance Committee has been reviewing the bylaws, which have not been revised since the School first opened. The Board discussed certain amendments during the 2018-2019 school year, and the Governance Committee is working to prepare a version for the Board's review and approval in the coming months.
