# **Call to Order:** (~2 min)

- At its last meeting, the Foundation Board discussed the Board's potential plans for expansion of the School.
- The group will be revising its bylaws this year as there currently exist multiple different versions, and it is unclear which version is controlling.
- Among the amendments will be a provision to add a seat for a member of PAWS and an additional seat for an ECS Board member.

#### PAWS Update: (~5 min)

- PAWS has selected performers for its cultural arts program. The goal this year was to work more with administration during the selection process to ensure better alignment between performances and School themes and curriculum.
- Picture day is Thursday, September 5th.
- PAWS launched its first Scrip ordering campaign of the year on September 3<sup>rd</sup>. This year's goal is to create more consistency in the offerings throughout the year. The Scrip program allows parents to purchase gift cards and, in return, PAWS gets a percentage of the purchase, ranging from 2% to 22% depending on the particular type of gift card. PAWS introduced the program last year primarily as a Space Camp fundraiser, and will be expanding the program this year focusing on different themes each month. The theme for September is travel.
- Staff appreciation day is next Tuesday, September 10<sup>th</sup>. PAWS will host a breakfast and ask parents to bring in something from each teacher's favorites list.
- The next PAWS social event is Sept 17<sup>th</sup> at Mod Pizza. PAWS is promoting the event primarily as a social gathering, but the group will also get a percentage of sales.
- Lunch blitz will take place the week of September 26<sup>th</sup>.
- The PAWS Meet and Mingle event (formerly, the Mane Event) will include a short presentation, ice breaker game, and prizes.
