- o Need to pay boost 46, 748.63. DE seconds, motion passed
- Budget approval
 - Assumed 2% increase. In past years did not include that assumption, but expect it to come in even higher than that for next year.
 - Student count is 783, that includes.
 - Salary scale is 95% of WCPSS scale. Still working to bridge the gap.this year increasing our salary by 2.3% assuming the step up.
 - Kept the fundraising number about the same as last year \$162k. This year, likely to end \$170k.
 - Budget is more conservative on rentals.
 - Overall, budget is very balanced. Not a lot of risks.

 - Monthly donations up to 33 families. Promising good feedback and immediate response. Annual fund is at \$98k. once fun run is included -

\$73k+. Possibility to acquire an additional \$10k if people follow through with the companies that they work for.

- \circ Report on Fun Run -67% of donors were non-parent donors. Outreach was criticals. 93% student participation (registration).
- Business Alliance Report. Michael Gottlieb reported that next meeting is tomorrow morning. 16-17 people on the Alliance, 6-7 rsvped for tomorrow. Plan is to discuss recruitment through the end of the year.
- OCDC is meeting tomorrow. Meeting with Corey Hutcherson with Wake Forest Chamber. 3 programs earmarked as potential beneficial for students and school to participate in. 1 is focused on entrepreneurial training getting teachers knowledgeable to identify the families that might want to get involved. They also do a financial literacy fair. Jaclyn volunteered at WFMS last month and wants to bring it to ECS. They run the program, just a call for volunteers on our end.
